- OGS Global employees shall not possess, use or consume, distribute or sell Alcohol or illicit unprescribed drugs or misuse prescribed medication while performing work for OGS Global.
- OGS Global will make every effort to provide assistance and rehabilitation to employees who have Alcohol and/or Drugs dependency in the form of reference to medical assistance or counselling if required.

OGS Global will require that its consultants, contractors, subcontractors and their employees comply with this policy.

Failure to comply may result in the termination of employment or contract with OGS Global.
